### **AFRICA TRANSITIONAL JUSTICE LEGACY FUND ANNOUNCES 2020 CALL FOR PROPOSALS!!!**

Accra, 11<sup>th</sup> March 2020

The Africa Transitional Justice Legacy Fund (ATJLF) is excited to announce its second Call for Proposals for funding. Eligible civil society organisations, community based groups and networks of organisations working on transitional justice and human rights issues in Cote d'Ivoire, Gambia, Guinea, Liberia, Mali, northeastern Nigeria and Sierra Leone are kindly encouraged to apply.

The ATJLF will be providing funding support to enable organisations implement transformative and impactful interventions in transitional justice processes in Africa. The Fund's goal is to help rebuild communities and (re) activate survivor agency in West Africa.

The Fund will be accepting applications that seek to address issues under the following broad themes. Proposals can cut across the three themes and not necessarily one:

- Truth, Justice & Accountability
- Reparations
- Institutional Reform & Enabling Environment

Applications should contain pioneering ideas that seek to promote community-centred and transformational projects that amplify the role of survivors and victims in transitional justice processes in West Africa. Proposed initiatives should be geared towards rebuilding communities, empowering citizens and transforming societies either in conflict, or those emerging from conflicts and dictatorships.

The ATJLF will be considering applications from **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2020**. Applications received after 26<sup>th</sup> April 2020 will not be considered in this round. Decisions for this round will be made by the ATJLF Advisory Committee in May/June 2020.
